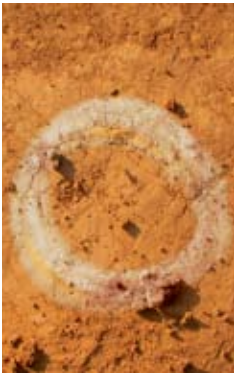
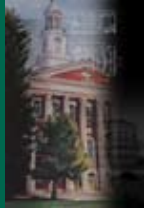

## **How does the message of *The Caucasian Chalk Circle* translate to today?**

"The message of *The Caucasian Chalk Circle* is very simple and true no matter what time period you live in; those who know the value of the things and people in their lives and take care of them as such are the true "owners" so to speak. Justice is not always black and white and one must have compassion and understanding in order to help their fellow man find justice for them. This meaning definitely reflects on today's society and the way things in our country are being run... well I think we can all figure out what that means! It's a very political play and I think its meaning will hit a lot of us close to home."
