**Virtuoso Series Concert Moran Woodwind Quintet**

A very active and visible quintet, the Moran Woodwind Quintet is the resident quintet of the University Of Nebraska School Of Music. Formed in 1986, the group tours extensively, often as guests at national and international music conventions. This program includes the music of classical composer Franz Danzi, and contemporary composers György Ligeti, Ronald Miranda, and Robert Muczynski.

One of the most active and visible quintets in the Midwest, the Moran Woodwind Quintet formed in 1986 and is named for the late John Moran, Director of the School of Music at the University of Nebraska. The Quintet has toured extensively, including performances in Kansas, Iowa, Ohio, Missouri, Colorado, Oklahoma, Illinois, South Dakota, Arkansas and Texas. They have also performed at conventions of the College Music Society, the International Double Reed Society and the International Horn Society. The Quintet has recorded three CD's for Crystal Records, including two CDs featuring music of the early 20th-century German composer Theodor Blumer and one with American woodwind quintets (music of Heiden, Higdon, Murdock and Lieuwen). The Quintet has also recorded on the Coronet label.

“The vision of people like Dr. Moran made possible a quintet like ours,” Dr. Bailey, flute, says on the quintet’s website. “When regional and national audiences hear our work, ranging from a standard repertoire to very modern pieces, we hope the strength of the University of Nebraska’s commitment to the arts comes through.”
