Hasse Borup, Assistant Professor of Violin and Chamber Music at the University of Utah School of the Arts, and internationally acclaimed pianist Mary Kathleen Ernst, perform Mozart's *Sonata in Bb major, K. 454*, several compositions by Judith Shatin (four-time recipient of the National Endowment for the Arts Fellowship), and Franck's *Sonata for Violin and Piano*. Borup and Ernst recently released their debut recording, *American Fantasies*, on Centaur Records.

Selections from Judith Shatin include *Icarus*, *Tower of Eight Winds*, and *Fledermaus Fantasy*. Shatin's inspirations range from myth, poetry, and animals to her Jewish heritage. She has been honored with four National Endowment for the Arts Fellowships, as well as awards from the American Music Center, Meet the Composer, the New Jersey State Arts Council and the Virginia Commission for the Arts. Shatin is currently William R. Kenan, Jr. Professor and Director of the Virginia Center for Computer Music, which she founded at the University of Virginia in 1987.

### About Hasse Borup

Danish violinist Hasse Borup was in 2005 appointed to the faculty of University of Utah School of Music and maintains a busy performance schedule at music series and festivals in the U.S. and internationally. Previous appointments include positions at University of Virginia and George Washington University. Mr. Borup has earned degrees in violin performance from the Royal Danish Conservatory of Music, the Hartt School of Music and a Doctor of Musical Arts Degree from the University of Maryland. Mr. Borup has also worked extensively with members of the Guarneri Quartet, Emerson Quartet, Isaac Stern, William Preucil, Roland and Almita Vamos, David Takeno and Hatto Beyerle. [READ MORE](#)
